Commitment.

Goals & Objectives.

- Identification, assessment and control of workplace hazards and risks
- Active commitment and involvement in Safety and Health matters by all site personnel
- Continuous improvement of company goals, objectives and methods for Safety and Health
- Maintaining, monitoring, reviewing, auditing and continually improving their Safety Management System and associated documents as aligned to AS/NZS 4801 for Safety Management Systems (SMS)

Responsibilities.

MK Construction Services Pty Ltd recognises that management has the overall responsibility to provide a safe workplace. Each management representative will be held accountable for implementing this policy in their area of responsibility. These responsibilities are contained in full in our Workplace Health and Safety Management Plan, but broadly encompass providing:

- a work environment without risks to health and safety;
- maintenance of safe plant and structures;
- safe systems of work;
- safe use, handling and storage of plant, structures and substances;
- workplace facilities for the welfare of workers;
- any information, training, instruction or supervision that is deemed necessary;
- adequate monitoring for the purpose of preventing illness or injury of workers.

Employees (including subcontractors) will ensure that they:

- Follow all H&S policies and procedures
- Report all hazards and incidents to their supervisor/project manager
- Are aware, at all times, of their own safety and the safety of those around them


Consultation.
